

Farmer's Market

Starting Sat. May 9th, the Farmer's Market will be moving to Isabella Street on the side closest to Delaware Avenue behind the PA Municipal Service building.

The Chamber of Commerce hosting an open-air farmer's market starting April 23, 2009 through the end of September, on the following days and times:

- Thursday afternoon and evening - 3:00 p.m. till 7:00 p.m.**
- Saturday mornings and afternoon - 8:00 a.m. till 1:00 p.m.**

The farmer's trucks will be parked on either side of the Clock Tower on Allegheny River Boulevard. They will provide fruits, vegetables, Amish jarred goods, snack mixes and seafood. There will be only one truck until mid-May when another farmer will join. We are hoping to grow the number of farmers and products with time. As this is a new venture for us, times might fluctuate and, as we add more farmers, the location may change as well. Any changes will be published in the Oakmont newsletter.
